

What is the Chamber?

Mission Statement: The McCreary County Chamber of Commerce is an organization of concerned citizens who promote business, professional, & civil interests in order to make McCreary County a better place to live. The Chamber strives for economic development in tourism, service, industry, agriculture & commerce.



Who Leads the Chamber?

The McCreary County Chamber of Commerce is run by its membership. All members have the same vote and are urged to serve on the various committees of the Chamber, as well as participate in the Chamber's regular monthly meetings & programs. The direction of its work and control of its by-laws are conducted by the Board of Directors consisting of President, a President Elect, Vice President, the immediate past President and five (5) other Board Members. Also elected are a Secretary & Treasurer. These people set policy & direction for the Chamber & are elected by the Chamber Membership with officers elected for a one year term and board members a three year term. They take office at the annual meeting held in October. Any member of the Chamber can be nominated for these positions. We also encourage members to participate in this capacity.

How Programs are Determined?

Chamber programs are determined by the Board of Directors with significant input from its membership. Committees are established on an as needed basis to meet the changing needs of the community. Committees may vary from year-to-year depending on the need. Committees are chaired by Board Members and Committee Members from the general membership.

The Chamber can only be successful through the active participation of its membership. Your contribution of a few hours a month can make a dramatic difference in your community and business.



How is the Chamber Financed?

Nearly all of the financial support necessary to maintain the Chamber's Office and carry on the activities of its committees comes from membership dues which are apportioned among the Chamber's Members, consisting of individuals, civic clubs, professionals and businesses who have an interest in making McCreary County a better place to live and work.

Since the Chamber is not a governmental agency, it receives no tax support. The County provides support, both moral and financial, through a number of agencies and programs dedicated to McCreary County's economic and community development.
